The Storm, Jesus, COVID-19

Matthew 14:22-33

Notes:

Text for the week:

[Jesus] replied, 'Don't let anyone mislead you. For many will come in my name, claiming to be the Messiah and saying, "The time has come!" But don't believe them. And when you hear of wars and insurrections, don't panic. Yes, these things must come, but the end won't follow immediately.' Then he added, 'Nations and kingdoms will proclaim war against each other. There will be great earthquakes, and there will be famines and *epidemics* in many lands, and there will be terrifying things and great miraculous signs in the heavens. But before all this occurs, there will be a time of great persecution. You will be dragged into synagogues and prisons, and you will be accused before kings and governors of being my followers. This will be your opportunity to tell them about me.'
