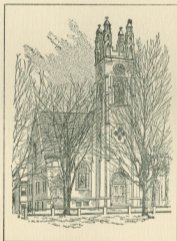

Historical Sketch.

THE First Evangelical Church in Clinton was organized November 14, 1844. Fifty-one persons constituted the original membership. Of this number twenty-six had previously been connected with the Evangelical Congregational Church in Lancaster, of which town the village of Clintonville was then a part. Public worship was held for nearly two years in a chapel, situated on Main, near the foot of Water street. To meet the wants of the increasing congregation a church was built on Walnut street and dedicated in the month of January, 1847; it was remodelled and rededicated February 22, 1859, and again enlarged in 1873. This building was taken down in 1898 and the present church edifice erected upon the same site and dedicated May 29, 1899. Since its formation, the growth of the church has been constant; few Communion seasons have passed without some additions. Special religious interest marked the years of 1861-'67-'70-'72 and '76. The benevolent offerings have correspondingly increased. Its history seems to have proved it a "branch of the Lord's planting: the work of His hands."

Ecclesiastical Principles.

A CHRISTIAN church is a voluntary association of professed believers in Christ, formed on the basis of the Holy Scriptures, united by solemn covenant for the worship of God, for the observance of Christian ordinances, for mutual aid and encouragement in all Christian duties, and for the spread of the gospel.

Each local church is complete in itself, recognizing no external authority, but obedient only to the Lord Jesus Christ, the Head of the Church Universal, under whose law alone it has a right to manage its own affairs.

Churches thus independent are yet connected by mutual duties, and co-operate as integral parts of the one Catholic Church.

The fellowship of Congregational churches is manifested in conferences for devotion and mutual encouragement, and in councils, convened for advice and assistance; but councils have no judicial or ecclesiastical power.

In common with other branches of the Christian Church, Congregationalists believe that the Ministry is ordained of Christ, but not that the power and authority of the Church reside in the ministry, or flow through it, but that they belong to the Church itself.

Congregationalists regard as true churches of Christ, all associations of believers who love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity and truth, and who receive him as their Divine Redeemer, Priest, and King; to all such they warmly extend the hand of Christian fellowship.

Officers of the Church.

PERMANENT OFFICERS.

I. A Pastor, who shall be moderator of all meetings of the church unless objection is made, in which case the Senior Deacon shall perform that duty.

II. Deacons, who shall preside at the meetings of the church in the absence of the Pastor; prepare for and assist in the celebration of the Lord's Supper; attend to the necessities of the poor of the church; provide a supply for the pulpit in the temporary absence of the Pastor, and give aid in the ministry of the church as may be needed.

TEMPORARY OFFICERS, *chosen by ballot at the Annual Meeting.*

I. A Clerk, who shall keep a full record of all action of the church; all motions with the vote thereon; the appointment and reports of committees, which shall be in writing. He shall also keep a book in which the names of all persons on becoming members of the church shall be recorded, with the time of admission and removal, whether by dismissal or death; in addition, he shall present at the annual meeting a list of those members who have been absent more than one year.

II. A Treasurer, who shall receive all moneys raised by the church for whatever purposes, and shall pay the same to such societies and benevolent

objects as the church from time to time may vote, and also for the expenses of the Communion Table. He shall also annually make a detailed report of the receipts and disbursements.

III. A Standing Committee, consisting of the Pastor, Deacons, and Clerk, and three or more persons chosen annually, whose duty it shall be to examine applicants for admission to the church; to act as Committee of Inquiry in cases of discipline; decide what objects shall be presented to the church for contributions, and have a general supervision over the interests of the church.

Vacancies in any of the offices above named occurring during the year, may be filled at any regular meeting of the church.

ANNUAL MEETING.

The Annual Meeting of the church shall be held on the third Tuesday in the month of January. Special meetings shall be called by the Pastor or the Standing Committee when they deem best, or whenever a request in writing is presented by six members of the church.

Discipline and Rules of the Church.

DISCIPLINE is the exercise of that authority and the application of that system of laws which the Lord Jesus has appointed in his Church.

The occasions of Church Discipline are either *public*, as wrong done to the church by neglect of its worship and ordinances, by disregard of its principles, rules, faith, or covenants, or by immoral conduct; or *private*, as wrong done to an individual.

All cases of discipline whether for private grievance or public offense shall be prosecuted according to the directions given by the Lord Jesus Christ, as recorded in Matt. xviii:15-17. No complaint shall be entertained by the church unless made in accordance with such instructions.

All complaints shall be made in writing and in the first instance to the Standing Committee, who shall upon sufficient cause present the same to the church; the complainant may after ten days present the same directly to the church. When a member is accused he shall be seasonably furnished with a copy of the charges against him, and shall have a full hearing, and the trial shall be had without unnecessary delay.

The censures inflicted on offenders shall be private reproof, public admonition, suspension, or excommunication, as the church shall determine. All cases of excommunication shall be announced from the pulpit on the Sabbath. An excommunicated person

may not be restored except on reformation of his conduct, public confession of his sin, and profession of his repentance. Admonition shall be administered by the Pastor, or if there be none, by the moderator of the church, in conformity with its vote.

In the decision of all matters that may come before the church the vote of the Pastor and each male member are in point of power equal.

Candidates for admission to the church by letter or profession shall be examined by the Standing Committee respecting the ground of their religious hope and belief; provided that any members of the church may attend these examinations, and make such inquiries and give such information as they may judge proper.

Members of other churches in fellowship with this, who regularly unite with us in worship and ordinances, are desired to transfer their membership to us without needless delay.

Members of this church who leave town for one year or more shall take letters of dismission and recommendation to some sister church, unless satisfactory reasons be given for a longer delay.

Previous to the stated administration of the Lord's Supper a general invitation shall be given to all present who love our Lord Jesus Christ, and who receive Him as their Divine Redeemer, Priest and King, to commune with this church, in the Holy Ordinance.

The seasons of communion to be observed by this church shall be six annually: on the first Sabbath in January, March, May, July, September and Novem-

ber; previous to each a preparatory lecture shall be given; at the close of which there shall be a stated Church Meeting for the transaction of any business that may come before the church.

All males over twenty-one years of age who have become members of the church, are also expected to become members of the parish, and all minors uniting with the church are expected to connect themselves with the parish when they shall arrive at the age of twenty-one years.

All members of this church who change their places of residence, shall within one year ask for letters of dismission from this church and of recommendation to another Evangelical Church; or forfeit their good standing until they shall report to the church satisfactory reasons for their neglect. Members who shall fail to comply with this rule shall be reminded by the Clerk of their neglect, and if the neglect continues, without good reason, or if nothing can be learned of them, the church may suspend watch and care over them. A list of such members shall, however, be kept, and letters of dismission to those judged worthy of them may subsequently be granted; but absentees belonging to this class shall not be included in reporting the list of members. Action similar to the above may also be taken in reference to persons resident among us, who have withdrawn from our fellowship by neglecting the ordinances of the church.

Any of the above articles may be altered or amended by a vote of the majority of the church present at any regular meeting.

Articles of Faith.

I. We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible;

And in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who is of one substance with the Father; by whom all things were made;

And in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of life, who is sent from the Father and Son, and who together with the Father and Son is worshiped and glorified.

II. We believe that the Providence of God, by which he executes his eternal purposes in the government of the world, is in and over all events; yet so that the freedom and responsibility of man are not impaired, and sin is the act of the creature alone.

III. We believe that man was made in the image of God, that he might know, love, and obey God, and enjoy him forever; that our first parents by disobedience fell under the righteous condemnation of God; and that all men are so alienated from God that there is no salvation from the guilt and power of sin except through God's redeeming grace.

IV. We believe that God would have all men return to him; that to this end he has made himself known, not only through the works of nature, the course of his providence, and the consciences of men, but also through supernatural revelations made

especially to a chosen people, and above all, when the fulness of time was come, through Jesus Christ his Son.

V. We believe that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the record of God's revelation of himself in the work of redemption; that they were written by men under the special guidance of the Holy Spirit; that they are able to make wise unto salvation; and that they constitute the authoritative standard by which religious teaching and human conduct are to be judged.

VI. We believe that the love of God to sinful men has found its highest expression in the redemptive work of his Son; who became man, uniting his divine nature with our human nature in one person; who was tempted like other men, yet without sin; who, by his humiliation, his holy obedience, his sufferings, his death on the cross, and his resurrection, became a perfect Redeemer; whose sacrifice of himself for the sins of the world declares the righteousness of God, and is the sole and sufficient ground of forgiveness and of reconciliation with him.

VII. We believe that Jesus Christ, after he had risen from the dead, ascended into heaven, where, as the one Mediator between God and man, he carries forward his work of saving men; that he sends the Holy Spirit to convict them of sin, and to lead them to repentance and faith; and that those who through renewing grace turn to righteousness, and trust in Jesus Christ as their Redeemer, receive for his sake the forgiveness of their sins, and are made the children of God.

VIII. We believe that those who are thus regenerated and justified, grow in sanctified character through fellowship with Christ, the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, and obedience to the truth; that a holy life is the fruit and evidence of saving faith; and that the believer's hope of continuance in such a life is in the preserving grace of God.

IX. We believe that Jesus Christ came to establish among men the kingdom of God, the reign of truth and love, righteousness and peace; that to Jesus Christ, the head of this kingdom, Christians are directly responsible in faith and conduct; and that to him all have immediate access without mediatorial or priestly intervention.

X. We believe that the Church of Christ, invisible and spiritual, comprises all true believers, whose duty it is to associate themselves in churches, for the maintenance of worship, for the promotion of spiritual growth and fellowship, and for the conversion of men; that these churches, under the guidance of the Holy Scriptures and in fellowship with one another, may determine—each for itself—their organization, statements of belief, and forms of worship; may appoint and set apart their own ministers, and should cooperate in the work which Christ has committed to them for the furtherance of the gospel throughout the world.

XI. We believe in the observance of the Lord's Day, as a day of holy rest and worship; in the ministry of the Word; and in the two Sacraments which Christ has appointed for his Church: Baptism, to be administered to believers and their children, as the

sign of cleansing from sin, of union to Christ, and of the impartation of the Holy Spirit; and the Lord's Supper as a symbol of his atoning death, a seal of its efficacy, and a means whereby he confirms and strengthens the spiritual union and communion of believers with himself.

XII. We believe in the ultimate prevalence of the kingdom of Christ over all the earth; in the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ; in the resurrection of the dead, and in a final judgment, the issues of which are everlasting punishment, and everlasting life.

FORM OF ADMISSION.

What shall I render unto the Lord for all his benefits towards me? I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the Lord. I will pay my vows unto the Lord now in the presence of all his people. (Ps. 116; 12-14.)

Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven. (Matt. 10:32, 33.)

For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. Rom. 10:10.)

Dearly beloved, called of God to be his children through Jesus Christ our Lord, you are here that, in the presence of God and his people, you may enter into the fellowship and communion of his Church. You do truly repent of your sins; you heartily receive Jesus Christ as your crucified Saviour and risen Lord; you consecrate yourselves unto God and your life to his service; you accept his Word as your law, and his Spirit as your Comforter and Guide; and,

trusting in his grace" to confirm and strengthen you in all goodness, you promise to do God's holy will, and to walk with this church in the truth and peace of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Response.—*I do.*

Accepting, according to the measure of your understanding of it, the system of Christian truth held by the churches of our faith and order, and by this church into whose fellowship you now enter; you join with ancient saints, with the Church throughout the world, and with us, your fellow believers, in humbly and heartily confessing your faith in the gospel, saying,—

I BELIEVE in God the FATHER Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. And in JESUS CHRIST, his only Son, our Lord; who was conceived by the HOLY GHOST, born of the Virgin Mary; suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead and buried; the third day he rose from the dead; he ascended into heaven; and sitteth at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from thence he shall come to judge the quick and the dead. I believe in the HOLY GHOST; the Holy catholic Church; the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen.

Then should baptism be administered to those who have not been baptized. Then should those rise who would unite with the church by letter. To them the minister should say:—

Confessing the Lord whom we unitedly worship, you do now renew your self-consecration, and join with us cordially in this, our Christian faith and covenant.

The members of the Church present should rise.

We welcome you into our fellowship. We promise to watch over you with Christian love. God grant that, loving and being loved, serving and being served, blessing and being blessed, we may be prepared, while we dwell together on earth, for the perfect communion of the saints in heaven.

"Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen." (Heb. 13:20, 21.)
