Ecclesiastical Brinciples.

A CHRISTIAN church is a voluntary association of professed believers in Christ, formed on the bar's of the Holy Scriptures, onited by solemn covenant for the worship of God, for the observance of Christian ordinances, for mutual aid and encouragement in all Christian duties, and for the spread of the worshe.

jesus Christ, the Head of the Church Universa under whose law alone it has a right to manage i own affairs.

Churches thus independent are yet connected by mutual duties, and co-operate as integral parts of the one Catholic Church.

The fellowship of Congregational churches is manifested in conferences for devotion and mutua encouragement, and in councils, convened for advice and assistance; but councils have no judicial or eccle

In common with other branches of the Christian Church, Congregationalists believe that the Ministry is ordained of Christ, but not that the power and authority of the Church reside in the ministry, or flow through it, but that they belong to the Church

Congregationalists regard as true churches of Christ, all associations of believers who love on Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity and truth, and wh receive him as their Divine Redeemer, Priest, an King: to all such they warmly extend the hand of Christian fellowship.

Officers of the Church.

PERMANENT OFFICER

- A Pastor, who shall be moderator of all meetings of the church unless objection is made, in which case the Senior Deacon shall perform that duty.
- II. Deacons, who shall preside at the meetings of the church in the absence of the Pastor; prepare for and assist in the celebration of the Lord's Supper; attend to the necessities of the poor of the church; provide a supply for the pulpit in the temporary absence of the Pastor, and give aid in the ministry of the showesh as many be necessarily.
- TEMPORARY OFFICERS, chosen by ballot at the Annual Meeting.
- 1. A Clerk, who shall keep a full record of all auction of the church all motions with the vote thereon, the appointment and reports of committees, which shall be in writing. - II. A Treasurer, who shall receive all moneys raised by the church for whatever purposes, and shall pay the same to such societies and benevolent

objects as the church from time to time may vote, and also for the expenses of the Communion Table. He shall also annually make a detailed report of the receive and dishusements.

III. A Standing Committee, consisting of the Pastor, Deacons, and Clerk, and three or more persons chosen annually, whose duty it shall be to examine applicants for admission to the church; to act as Committee of Inquiry in cases of discipline; decide what objects shall be presented to the church for contributions, and have a general supervision contributions, of the above.

ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting of the church shall be held on the third Tuesday in the month of January, Special meetings shall be called by the Fastor or the Standing Committee when they deem best, or whenever a request in writing is presented by six members of the church.

Discipline and Bules of the Church.

DISCIPLINE is the exercise of that authority and the application of that system of laws which the Lord Jesus has appointed in his Church.

public, as wrong done to the church by neglect of its worship and ordinances, by diaregard of its principles, rules, faith, or covenants, or by immoral conduct; or private, as wrong done to an individual.

All cases of discipline whether for private grievance or public offense shall be prosecuted according to the directions given by the Lord Jesus Christ, are recorded in Matt. xviii:15-17. No complaint shall be entertained by the church unless made in accordaccountily and instructions.

All complaints shall be made in writing and in the first instance to the Standing Committee, who shall upon sufficient cause present the same to the church the complainant may after ten days present the same directly to the church. When a member is accused the shall be seasonably turnished with a copy of the charges against him, and shall have a full hearing, and the trial shall be had without unneces-

The censures inflicted on offenders shall be private reproof, public admonition, suspension, or excommunication, as the church shall determine. All cases of excommunication shall be announced from the pulpit on the Sabbath. An excommunicated person may not be restored except on reformation of his conduct public confession of his sin, and profession of his repentance. Admonition shall be administered by the Pastor, or if there be none, by the moderator of the church, in conformity with its vote.

Articles of Waith
