It is I who made the earth, and created man upon it. I stretched out the heavens with My hands, And I ordained all their host. ... I have not spoken in secret, In some dark land; I did not say to the offspring of Jacob, "Seek Me in a waste place"; I, the LORD, speak righteousness Declaring things that are upright.
